<u>Lakeview Special Appeal Update</u> - In September for our Special Appeal, we received \$7,230 of which \$4,000 was a donation from our United Church Women. With matching funds, we advanced \$14,460 toward our goal. To date we have received \$30,360 toward our goal of \$41,000 so we are three-quarters of the way there! NEW HORIZONS SENIORS GRANT PROGRAM UPDATE

Lakeview received funding from the Federal New Horizons Seniors Grant Program for 2025/2026 to offer two previously run programs again. Both programs were very popular, filled up quickly and received positive feedback from attendees. Seniors, ages 55+ are eligible to attend.

The **Computer Literacy program** was offered in May/June, 2025 with twenty seniors attending. Topics included learning how to use a computer, what is the Internet & how to use it safely, online socializing, banking, shopping & gaming apps, how to avoid financial & online scams and basic cellphone knowledge & skills.

The **Seniors – Planning Ahead program** was held in September, 2025 with thirty seniors attending. Over the past 18 months, a total of 126 seniors have participated in this program. Topics included wills & estate planning, power of attorney, advance care planning, options for end of life care, estate taxes, role of the executor, funerals and grief & bereavement. This program will be offered again in Feb/March, 2026.

Many thanks are extended to the presenters and the lunch volunteers who have made these programs so successful.

Lakeview has submitted a proposal to the Federal New Horizons Seniors Grant Program for funding for 2026/2027 to continue to offer the Seniors – Planning Ahead program. We will not find out if this proposal has been approved until February, 2026.
